Project title: Capacity Building for Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs) and Unintentional Persistent Organic Pollutants (UPOPs) project in The Gambia

Background

The GEF-funded project is implemented in partnership with relevant institutional and industrial stakeholders, including the National Environment Agency (NEA), Ministry of Environment, Climate Change & Natural Resources (MECCNAR), National Water and Electricity Co. Ltd (NAWEC), and others. The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) is the Implementing Agency for the project and the United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR) provides technical support.

The project aims at strengthening the capacity of national stakeholders to manage PCBs and achieve PCB elimination, address contaminated sites in an environmentally sound manner, and reduce uPOPs from opening burning, as identified as national priorities in the Gambia's NIP for the Stockholm Convention.

Objectives

The project Implementing Partner, National Environment Agency seeks the services of a competent consulting team or firm to develop an environmental and social risk management plan for PCBs and contaminated sites.
